GET REFERRED

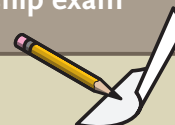
- > Get referred to a union apprenticeship training program in one of the 17 building trades

STEP 4

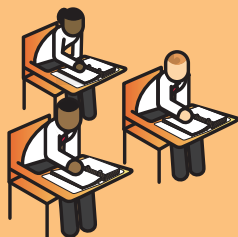
INTERVIEW

TRAINING PLUS UNION MEMBERSHIP

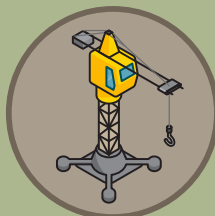
Requirements vary based on trade specific apprenticeship programs.

- > Start earning right away

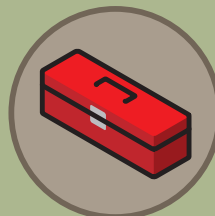


STEP 6
